Trigger Finger and Thumb Pathway

Patient presents triggering in fingers or thumb



Confirm diagnosis clinically in particular:

- Fingers or thumb triggering or history of triggering or getting stuck flexed
- Identification and palpation of painful tendon or nodule in palm or thenar eminence at level of MCPJ



PATIENT EDUCATION:

- Advice re use of splints
- Activity modification and ergonomics
- Advice re exercises

Analgesia/NSAID – topical

Offer steroid injection if:

- Failure of conservative treatment
- Symptoms significantly affecting ADL's

Consider Chronic pain

Complete the MSK Service with the clinical details requested and refer to Community MSK if:

- No response to conservative treatment or recurrence within 6 months maybe worth second injection
- Significant interference with ADL's
- Patient would consider surgery
